The 12-story, 185-unit **Tapestry** apartment building, at **124th Street** and **Second Avenue**, has finally opened its doors. Last week, co-developers **Jonathan Rose Cos.** and **Lettire Construction Corp.** held a ribbon-cutting at the project, which is part of the 125th Street **River to River Rezoning**, a multi-city agency effort to **infuse** the area with cultural, retail, entertainment, and residential uses. It's also on track to become East Harlem's first **LEED Gold** rental residential development.
